COMPARING THE 2 TYPES OF INFLUENCES



Conditions, not under the control of the project team that influence, constrain, or direct the project

Can enhance or constrain project outcomes positively or negatively

EEFs can be internal or external to the org

Are used as inputs to many project management processes, especially Planning processes

2 types of EEFs:
- Internal
- External



Plans, processes, policies, procedures, and knowledge bases specific to and used by the performing org

Influence the management of the project

OPAs are internal to the org

Are used as inputs to many project management processes

2 types of OPAs:
- Processes, policies, and procedures
- Organizational knowledge bases
